Rules

1. Students may start collecting pledges (not money) on September 18th, 2020. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be completed online or sent/dropped off to school by Thursday, October 8th.**
2. This year students have a full week to complete one hour of a favorite physical activity of their choice! **Grown-ups: Please take a short video of your child doing their activity** and email it to artsparkrun@thecottonwoodschool.org and **fill out the Online Activity Log** (coming in email and CSCS Parent Group FaceBook page) with the type of activity and duration they did it for, up to one hour. Note that only one hour of activity will be counted towards the Arts Park Run this year.
3. Pledges may be made by anyone. However, participants may not ask for pledges from any of the staff members of The Cottonwood School.
4. Donations can be made online at any time at this link: (<https://secure.ggiv.com/for/artparru>). Make checks out to CSCS and include the student's name in the memo. For cash and check donations, please drop them in the **locked** mailbox out in front of the school. Please put all donation payments in a sealed envelope and include the name of the child you are sponsoring, your name, and the amount donated. Questions?
